Note that this gearset aims to balance out stats evenly to avoid diminishing returns, so individual pieces may not suit your current gearset on their own. 3. Overcharged Delves Guide Introduced at Item Level 691, similar to Cyrce's Circlet from earlier in the expansion this upgrades over time up to Item Level 701. The belt comes with no secondary stats, but instead has 9 proc options available that can be selected from the belt itself. Once you've unlocked a power on your character, you can right-click at any time out of combat to switch to any of the available options. Currently, the belt is worth using immediately as you get it, and only improves with item level. It's roughly 1.5% better in single-target scenarios, while maintaining similar power gains in AoE - making it the best belt option available to round out the current season. Havoc has a handful of worthwhile options depending on the content: Raid/Single-Target - Critical Chain (Crit) Mythic+/AoE - Critical Chain (Crit) Open World/Delves - Critical Chain (Crit) Following the changes after the launch of the patch, secondary procs are the pick of choice regardless of the situation. Due to improvements to Critical Chain alongside it being Havoc's stat of choice, it is now the best pick regardless of the situation. 4. Best Puzzling Cartel Chip Purchases for Havoc Demon Hunter Patch 11.1.5 provided a way to acquire specific items from Liberation of Undermine through the Puzzling Cartel Chip. These can be acquired following a quest released on May 13th that will reward you with chips for defeating bosses within the Liberation of Undermine raid on a weekly cadence. You can purchase any trinkets or special cantrip items available within the raid, and also available are trinkets on Myth track from the Season 2 dungeon pool. Purchasing an item, however, does require you to have defeated the boss. Each item drops from each respective difficulty. As an example, to purchase The Jastor Diamond Mythic, you need to have defeated Mythic Chrome King Gallywix. Trinkets from dungeons also require you to have compiled a list of high-value items that you should prioritize with your Cartel Chips in The War Within Season 2 as Havoc Demon Hunter. This has uses regardless of the content, so if you're unhappy with your current trinkets this may be a priority purchase for you. Due to this aspect, it's much more suited to Mythic raid encounters that last long enough to pull value out of it - in particular the final three bosses in Liberation of Undermine. Due to this, ramp time though and the stacks fading in between combat, it's less suited to Heroic raid content or Mythic +. If you do not intend to defeat Mythic bosses within Undermine on Mythic to that content is Signet of the Priory. As purchasing these items requires you to have defeated Mythic bosses to acquire them at the highest level, if you ever intend to kill those then hold off on buying a heroic version. You will only receive 3 total purchases through the remainder of the season, so use them wisely! 5. Best Cyrce's Circlet Gems for Havoc Demon Hunter Cyrce's Circlet is a customizable ring that can be obtained from the Siren Isle. There are three distinct sockets each with 4 choices each, allowing you to build your own item to suit your needs. The ring stays a very strong option, only being evened out by well itemized 665 equivalent rings - though this can sometimes require higher item level if you have a lot of Mastery to empower Fathomdweller's Runed Citrine. That means you can safely use this for most if not all of Season 2. With Havoc leaning toward Aldrachi Reaver this season, all it is really looking for is high value stat picks. Having on-use options to empower Metamorphosis burst is nice though, especially if you are trying out Fel-Scarred. 7.1. Best Crafted Items for Havoc Demon Hunter Crafted gear for Havoc in The War Within Season 2 has a few embellishments worth looking at, but one in particular is a consistently worthwhile craft — Darkmoon Sigil: Ascension. It's also a Nerubian enchant that can be doubled up with Writhing Armor Banding. You should ideally sim the optimal stats to craft for your particular character, but Critical Strike and Mastery is most likely your best option with an Algari Missive of the Peerless. 8.1. Best Crafting Order for Havoc Demon Hunter First, craft weapon Everforged Warglaive with a Darkmoon Sigil: Ascension applied. Next, craft an off-piece and apply Writhing Armor Banding to double the effect — Any will do but Rune-Branded Grasps provide better stats than the other best options. Alternatively, you can opt into using Dawnthread Lining for the passive Critical Strike, as it performs slightly better in ideal gear setups, and does not require you to invest in a weapon if you so wish. After this, you are done with priority crafts and embellishments and can use sims to determine your best piece to upgrade with item level. Generally, it is a good idea to look for Rings and Necks as good options are very contested among other classes. The value of crafting a high item-level weapon early on in the season for maximum value is high, though it is not the strongest pick in perfected gear setups. If you get hold of some good weapons early, or in particular Capo's Molten Knuckles, you can instead pivot toward Dawnthread Lining crafts on off-pieces. Note that any Agility one-handed weapon can be crafted, meaning you have a choice between Everforged Warglaive, Charged Facesmasher or Everforged Longsword. The choice is purely cosmetic and does not affect performance. 9. "Simming" Yourself as a Havoc Demon Hunter Throughout this page and elsewhere in our guide, we regularly refer to the importance of simming yourself on Raidbots. This is because every character is unique, and each gear piece you have access to can change what is best right now for you. While we do offer generic sim charts and recommendations for Trinkets, these are not complete replacements for simming yourself. Best Gear Upgrades for Havoc Demon Hunter As you complete endgame content in The War Within, you will gather upgrade d a slot to a particular item level, any other item in that slot can be upgraded without a Crest cost. As Crests are a limited resource and capped early on in the season, ideally, you will want to obtain the highest item-level possible before committing any crests to upgrades in the long run. If you are capable of completing higher Mythic+ dungeons, it is generally a good idea to wait until you have the slot maxed out with free upgrades first. Below is a general slot priority you should upgrade your items in. Weapons Trinkets Helm/Chest/Legs Shoulders/Gloves/Belt/Boots Rings and Necks Cloaks and Bracers Note that exceptions are possible, such as special items that have additional procs attached to them like The Jastor Diamond. 11. The second Tier Set of The War Within, the Fel-Dealer's Contraband, consists of 5 items that provide unique bonuses upon equipping 2 and 4 pieces from the set: Demon Hunter Havoc 11.1 Class Set 2pc — Your spells and abilities have a chance to trigger Winning Streak!, increasing the damage of Blade Dance and Chaos Strike, stacking up to 10 times. Blade Dance and Chaos Strike have a 15% chance to remove all stacks. Necessary Sacrifice — Winning Streak! persists for 10 seconds after being removed, and additionally grants 2% Critical Strike per stack consumed for 15 seconds. The Havoc set bonus is of average strength, and has no gameplay implications due to being background passive procs that happen throughout gameplay. It is still definitely worth picking up for the bonus effects as soon as possible. You can use the Matrix Catalyst to convert regular items (from Mythic+ or Raid) into Tier pieces in slots you are missing. You only need 4 pieces to maximize the set bonus, so we recommend dropping the Gloves or Helm in favor of an alternative with more Critical Strike or Mastery if possible. Beyond this stat, you'll want to prioritize Mastery. This stat increases our movement speed and Chaos damage, and with Any Means Necessary. added into the mix, this affects all of our abilities. This makes it almost necessary to maximize this stat so you can throw out the most amount of damage possible. Since it constantly procs for a solid amount of primary stat, this can greatly help with our consistent throughput. You will then need a Prized Gladiator's Medallion to break out of CC every 2 minutes.
