The application period for new civil service exams generally begins on the first Wednesday of each month. This item is available in full to subscribers. STATEN ISLAND, N.Y. — The New York City Department of Citywide Administrative Services has released its May application schedule for civil service exams.Open, competitive, computer-based tests are administered throughout each month for various positions. If you meet the basic requirements of the job, you can apply for your exam online at Online Application System or at one of the Computer-Based Testing and Application Centers.This month's application period opened May 1 for the following positions: auto mechanic; auto mechanic (CUNY); auto mechanic (diesel); fingerprint technician trainee; fitness instructor; housing assistant; locksmith; locksmith (CUNY); locksmith (NYC H+H); marine oiler (ferry operations); plan examiner (buildings); program producer; quality assurance specialist; school food service manager; school safety agent; steam fitter's helper; and steam fitter's helper (CUNY).The starting salary for each career varies, according to the city.Most of these exams have a deadline of May 21. The exam deadline for school safety agent is open through June 13.Additionally, the application remains open for the following roles: administrative space analyst, through May 13; call center representative, through May 21; police officer, through May 20; and traffic enforcement agent, through June 6.New York City employs hundreds of thousands of people in its 80 agencies. Taking a test is the way to get started in the hiring process for most of these positions.
