With a fragile ceasefire between Israel and Iran taking effect on Tuesday morning, the full scope of the 12-day conflict began to unfold. US President Donald Trump's declaration of ceasefire two hours later was met with a surge from Iran, which launched two more ballistic missiles at Israel, triggering sirens in northern Israel. The projectiles were intercepted, prompting the IDF to retaliate and strike an Iranian radar north of Tehran, seemingly ending the fighting. The civilian toll from Iran's ballistic missile attacks on Israel during the 12-day war claimed 28 lives — all but one civilians — and wounded over 3,000 people. A total of 3,238 people were hospitalized, including 23 seriously injured, 111 moderately, 2,933 lightly, 138 who suffered acute anxiety, and another 30 whose conditions remain undetermined. The vast majority of the casualties were civilians, with just seven soldiers hurt in one missile impact in central Israel and an off-duty soldier killed in Beersheba. Over 9,000 people have been displaced from their homes, dozens of which were damaged or destroyed by the Iranian attacks. During the war, Iran launched between 550 ballistic missiles and around 1,000 drones at Israel, with most intercepted by Israeli and American air defenses at a 90 percent interception rate. At least 31 missile impacts were reported in populated areas or critical infrastructure sites, including a power station in southern Israel and an oil refinery in Haifa. The IDF's air defense systems played a crucial role in intercepting the drones, with nearly 99% of those posing a threat to Israel neutralized by fighter jets, helicopters, and ground-based air defense systems. The Israeli Navy also contributed, intercepting some missiles from the sea. Security services issued over 21,000 alerts to civilians amid the war, while Iran's remaining capabilities were significantly reduced. At the start of the conflict, Iran was estimated to have around 2,500 ballistic missiles and many thousands of drones, but the IDF destroyed hundreds of launchers and missiles, leaving Iran with a limited arsenal. Iran says Israeli airstrikes caused significant damage to nuclear facilities, eliminated top commanders, and killed hundreds of civilians
