Although the Singapore Zoo opens quite early, visitors don't begin to swarm there until late morning. One may gain a front-row seat to the exhibits and the feeding performances by getting there early.Accessibility: You may either bring your own stroller or wheelchair to the park, or you can rent one there. Please be aware, though, that if you're taking a tram trip, all strollers and chairs must be folded before entering the train.By Bus: Bus Route 138 provides efficient connectivity from the Singapore Zoo to various parts of the city.
