University Transportation and NYU's partnership with various bus routes offer several options for students to travel between campus locations. During the fall and spring semesters, buses operate from 7 am to 12 midnight on weekdays and 10 am to 12 midnight on weekends. For more information, including route schedules and real-time bus location maps, please refer to NYU's Transportation website. NYU Bus Route provides convenient transportation for students living in or near specific neighborhoods, such as Chinatown, Gramercy, University Court, and NYU Langone Medical Center. To access the bus schedule, visit . Alternatively, download the Transloc app on your iPhone to receive up-to-date real-time information on bus locations. Recently, NYU introduced a new weekend bus service between Washington Square campus and the Tandon School of Engineering in Brooklyn. The limited weekday and Friday services are supplemented by this free, four-stop route, offering students a more affordable alternative to public transportation. The new weekend bus service for NYU was only recently introduced, with some students feeling it could be better advertised or that the schedule is too limited. Several students were unaware of the new service, including Tandon freshman Tommy Gao, who found out about it on the NYU website. Gao expressed his experience, stating that he had to be aware of the bus schedule in order not to wait for an hour at the bus stop.
