A device for making a video call, such as a smartphone, tablet or computer with a webcam and speaker (often built into laptops) A reliable internet connection should be good enough for a video call An up to date version of the Edge, Safari or Chrome web browser Ideally, a private, well-lit area for your consultation. To join your call, type the link you have been provided into the address bar above. Then follow the instructions on screen. Near Me is a video consulting service that enables people to attend appointments from home or wherever is convenient. The service is widely used across NHS Scotland, Social Security Scotland, Local Authorities and other organisations for appointments across a wide range of public services. All you need is a secure form of video consulting approved for use by the Scottish Government and NHS Scotland. No Near Me calls for health and care calls are ever recorded and no personal information is stored by the system. You do not need to download an App or create an account to use Near Me. This troubleshooting page on the Attend Anywhere website provides further help: Sometimes an appointment can be completed by telephone but in other situations a video consultation provides additional benefits. For medical appointments these include enabling the clinician to make a fuller clinical assessment such as examining a skin rash, assessing a patient's breathing rate, or reviewing how someone uses an inhaler. In other services, like money advice or help with benefit applications, the ability to share the screen can provide help filling out forms. Using the camera also let you show people what is needed, for example when considering adaptations to your home or when requesting repairs. Near Me is the name for video consulting in Scotland. The name Near Me was picked by members of the public who helped co-design the service. Attend Anywhere is the brand name of the video consulting platform that underpins Near Me. On a WiFi or wired internet connection, Near Me calls do not cost anything. If using mobile data: waiting for your call to be connected a typical 20 minute Near Me call will cost 230MB of data on a mobile device. Data use is less on lower speed connections. You should contact your provider who will advise you on how to re-arrange your appointment or attend in a different way.
