On an iPhone, open the Phone app, go to the "Contacts" tab, and tap on "My Card" to find your phone number. On an Android device, swipe down from the top of the screen, tap the gear icon to open Settings, and open "About Phone" to find your phone number. It's a little embarrassing, but we've all had the thought at one time or another: "What is my phone number?" Maybe you recently got a new number or you're just having a mental lapse. The good news is you can find in the settings on your iPhone or Android device. Find Your Phone Number on iPhone To find your phone number on an iPhone, open the "Phone" app. Next, from the "Contacts" tab, tap your "My Card" at the top. You'll see your phone number will be shown on this screen! On Android devices, the process is very straightforward. First, swipe down once or twice from the top of the screen, then tap the gear icon to open the Settings. Scroll all the way down to "About Phone." You'll see your phone number listed somewhere on this screen! That's all there is to you. Hopefully, this isn't something you have to look up frequently, but when you do, it's easy to find. Phone numbers sometimes feel like a relic with all the different messaging apps we have, but they're still important. This is a guide on how to check own number on iPhone. Especially when receiving a new cell number from your carrier, you'll want to look it up from time to time, until you memorize it. Some iPhone owners never memorize their own number and want to find out their own number. Where to look, you might ask? Your Contacts-App is not a reliable indicator of the currently active number that is connected to your SIM card, although it makes sense to configure yourself as a contact on your iPhone for quickly sharing your details with other people. A completely reliable way to check your own number is achieved by checking the Phone app, which is typically used for answering or making calls. iPhone: My Number (how to check) Phone app > Contacts > Top entry Open up your Phone application by tapping the green icon that looks like a telephone receiver from the olden days. At the bottom of the screen, you'll find several buttons for the tabbed sections of the app. Tap Contacts to continue. Now, at the very top of the list, you should see your own number listed as my iPhone. You can even use this trick to look up your number while in a conversation with a caller. Another way to access the content of this field is achieved via the Settings app, where you can even edit the number that is listed. We do however recommend to not change the value inside the field, as it kind of defeats the purpose of having a reliable and automatic entry for your own number. Settings > Phone To check the field via the Settings app, go to the Phone section inside your settings panel and then check the field at the very top, which is also labeled My iPhone. This method may require having signal and not being in Airplane Mode. Its surprisingly easy to forget your own phone number with the sleuth of instant messaging platforms available on iPhone. Take me as an example. I use Messenger and WhatsApp every day, so I rarely need to call or text people. Its embarrassing that I cant recall this short 10-digit number. Of course, that doesnt mean I (or anyone else, for that matter) should forget these contact details altogether. Whether you just switched to a new phone or are using a temporary SIM card, the search can feel more complicated than it should. But dont call your carrier just yet for help. Heres a quick, easy guide to navigate your Phone and Settings apps. Time needed: 2 minutes Apple syncs and saves your contact information across your linked devices automatically. In most cases, you'll have a Contact Poster or card in the Phone app. Its the quickest and easiest solution here unless your iPhone displays your iMessage email address instead. Open the Phone app and go to Contacts. Tap [Apple ID profile name] My Card. Check the Phone section. The Settings app shows you all essential information about your device, including your phone number. It pulls this data straight from your SIM card, so you can rest assured that its 100 percent accurate and reliable. Go to the Settings app. Open Phone on iOS 18, scroll down to Apps > Phone. You'll see your contact information listed in My Number. Users with two SIM cards (physical SIM and eSIM) should go straight to the SIM Settings section under Cellular in Settings. This is the quickest way to view details for each SIM card. NOTE You can also take this chance to set or update your SIM PIN if you forget it frequently. Creating an extra layer of security prevents unauthorized use of your SIM card if your device phone is ever lost. Having a PIN also adds a step during phone reboots, but its worth the peace of mind. Open Settings. Tap Cellular. Select SIM Applications (if available, depending on carrier) or SIM PIN. Look for your phone number listed under the SIM settings. iMessage and FaceTime will display the email and phone number registered to your account. Just note that you might have more than one enabled. Its a good idea to cross-check any details you find with the above solutions listed. Open Settings. Tap Messages or FaceTime on iOS 18, scroll down to Apps first. You'll see your contact details listed under the You Can Be Reached By iMessage At or You Can Be Reached By FaceTime At sections. Some carriers display phone numbers on device lock screens for quick access during emergencies. Its useful if you need to share your details fast without unlocking your device. Although this feature isnt universal across all carriers, theres no harm in double-checking while troubleshooting. When all else fails, the simplest method is often the most effective: call a friend. Your phone number is shown on the recipients device when you make a phone call this works whether youre using a physical SIM or eSIM. You'll find this trick helpful if the issue is related to your SIM activation or iPhone. It bypasses any iOS bugs or glitches hiding your contact details, but the downside is you'll need someone to receive your call. Open the Phone app. Dial the number of a friend or family member. Once the call connects, ask them to check their caller ID for your phone number. Write down the number, or ask them to text it back to you. At least one of the above solutions is guaranteed to show your contact details. If not, there might be an issue with your SIM card. Its probably not fully activated yet, or there are geo-specific issues with your network. Your mobile carrier should have a more detailed explanation for you.
